Tutors meet with SSS program participants on an individual basis and are responsible for facilitating the arrangement of times and locations for tutoring sessions. SSS tutors must be successful West Virginia University students in good academic standing, and must be flexible, patient, and sensitive to the specific needs of the SSS student population.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- > Full-time undergraduate or graduate student at WVU in good standing
- ➤ Cumulative grade-point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale

APPLICATION PROCESS:

Applicants must submit a completed **application**; an **academic transcript** (may be unofficial), and **two letters of reference** from an instructor, employer, staff member, or person who can speak to your abilities and/or character. Finalists will be selected for an interview. If no vacancies are available, applications will be kept on file for one year from the date of submission and will be considered for future openings.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT:

Tutors earn a starting wage of \$10.00 per hour. Graduate students start at \$11.00 per hour. Employment is contracted for one semester, with subsequent employment contingent upon satisfactory performance evaluations and need for assistance in specified content areas.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Schedule tutoring appointments within assigned time-frame
- Complete and submit all forms as directed
- Arrive on time and utilize full scheduled time for tutoring and instruction
- Review syllabi and course material in advance
- Use interactive tutoring techniques
- Provide peer advising and study skills tutoring, when appropriate
- Attend all staff training sessions and meetings
- Maintain a 3.0 grade-point average
- Possess extensive knowledge of campus support programs and resources
